Being a member of Thomas Clarkson Academy Sixth Form is a privilege. You will study in a first-class, modern learning environment with two areas dedicated solely for Sixth Form students, complete with computers and quiet study space.

All students who attend TCA Sixth Form are issued with their own laptop to work on both in the building and at home. As a Microsoft Showcase School, we pride ourselves for ensuring our students are computer literate; students will use OneNote, Microsoft Teams and Office365 as part of their day to learning. Using these technologies to collaborate with teachers and other students is key to ensuring we have an outstanding learning experience.

In line with our whole academy philosophy, we expect our Sixth Form students to have a business-like attitude and appearance. As part of this you will attend each day, for the full day, using any free periods to carry out independent study.

You will also be part of one of the academy's three learning communities, be a member of a Sixth Form specific tutor group and will be expected to set a good example to younger students, acting as a role model and mentor.

Life Beyond Sixth Form

TCA will guide you through the crucial decisions and options facing you through your Sixth Form education. We ensure you have developed all the necessary skills, achieved the required grades and developed the knowledge to excel on your chosen path.

All students have access to a specialist careers adviser to support you in making your Post-18/19 decisions. The CEIAG team will work closely with Sixth Form staff to assist you through applications, personal statements and the UCAS process.

There is also specific support for those wishing to apply to Russell Group universities.

With frequent off-site visits to career fairs, university campuses and skills shows, as well as regular guest speakers from a number of organisations, we provide you with a range of experiences to inform your decisions.

Entry Requirements

Those wishing to study at Sixth Form need to secure **five 9-5 grade subjects**. Those choosing A Levels need a grade 6 in selected subjects to study them at A Level (Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, English). A grade 6 is required in all other subjects that students wish to study at A Level.

Those opting for BTECs need to secure a merit in their selected BTEC subjects.

Please note that the final courses that we run may be different to those listed. This will be due to whether the course is viable.

Enrichment and Personal Development

Enrichment

At TCA we understand that universities and employers look for more than excellent academic success. Our students are given opportunities to develop essential skills outside the classroom.

We have developed an extensive Session 6 enrichment programme that will open up a wide range of different experiences to you. It is important that you take as much as you can from this programme, as it will help you to develop new skills and manage the transition between school life and early adulthood.

Within our specifically designed Session 6 programme, you will take part in and lead a variety of different sessions to build skills such as teamwork and communication.

There are also opportunities to take part in the running of the academy. A student leadership team is selected from the Sixth Form and our Sixth Formers lead our Student Voice, a school-wide forum which ensures students' suggestions and comments are fed back to the Academy's senior leadership team.

Work Experience

All Year 12 students will be provided with a professionally managed one-week work experience placement. This will be a high quality placement designed specifically to meet the individual's career aspirations.

Trips


Sixth Form students enjoy a wide variety of trips to complement their academic studies and expand their cultural capital and personal development. These range from field and theatre trips, to skiing trips and other residentials.

Our curriculum includes a residential team building weekend at the beginning of each academic year, fully funded. We also offer our annual city break which alternates between London and a European city. In 2023 we took the Eurostar to Brussels and in 2024 we are heading to London.
