TCA Mobile phone policy 2020-21

Mobile Phones and Electronic Equipment guidance

Procedure:

1. The school follows a Covid-19 secure 'See it, hear it, take it' policy. This will simply mean that the phone can be confiscated if it is used in school grounds.
2. Phones that are confiscated will be returned by the end of the school day or at a time in the day deemed fit by that member of staff.
3. The restriction is always in place while students are in the grounds of the school, this includes when students arrive and leave at the end of the day. Phones should be put away before students enter the school gates and not accessed until they have left the site.
4. Students will be able to contact home by approaching Student Services team if they require to speak with their parent/carer.
5. We will ensure that any important messages are relayed to your child through the day if you leave a message at reception.
6. Students who refuse to hand the phone over to a member of staff will be have failure to follow instructions sanctions in line with the Covid-19 behaviour addendum.
